Reporting of the college activities by the Principal

Principal, Dr. Biju C.S. informed the meeting the following:

- The University is taking steps for approving our decision to start three new programmes, namely, BBA (Hons) Logistics and Supply Chain Management, BSc(Hons) Aquaculture and MSW from 2026-27 academic year onwards.
- Renovation of the Chemistry lab is going on with the CSR fund (Rs. Fifty Lakh) of the South Indian Bank
- More than 300 students from the final year batches got placement in different Organizations
- Sacred Heart College received the Minister's Award for Excellence at Excellencia 2025 in recognition of its top NIRF ranking and commitment to quality and academic excellence.
- Sacred Heart College signed an MoU with UNITAR International University, Malaysia.
- Sacred Heart College has signed an MoU with SWAYAM Plus, an initiative supported by IIT Madras and the Ministry of Education, Govt. of India.
- Fr. Berchmans Hall, a new auditorium at the SH East Campus with a seating capacity of 250 was inaugurated on 08 January 2026.
- The Prof. Mathew Ulakamthara Chair was established at Sacred Heart College, Thevara, to commemorate and honour the legacy of Professor Mathew Ulakamthara, a distinguished academician, author, and teacher, and was inaugurated on 28 January 2026.
- The research wing organized the first Heartian Research Congress 2026, an annual academic platform dedicated to fostering a spirit of innovation and excellence among researchers.

- The college secured championship titles in six categories, including Women's Handball, Lawn Tennis, and Football, as well as Men's Chess, Cycling, and Handball. Additionally, the institution earned runner-up positions in Women's Taekwondo and Men's 3-on-3 Basketball, Lawn Tennis, and Table Tennis.
- Four players represented the country at the international level, 21 at the state level, and 61 at the university level, showcasing our institution's excellence in sports.

Agenda Item No. 3: Examination Malpractice cases

The Examination Committee considered malpractice cases involving 07 students in the End Semester Examinations conducted in October-November 2025. The candidates are 1) Franklin Babu (23UBBA12050) 2) Thanseem Shihab (23UBBA12047) 3) Vallabh S Jain (24HEMS14711) 4) Ajith C V (24HCTX14152) 5) Muhammed Yaseen T S (23UCTX11518) 6) Diya Fathima Vinshad (25HBCA18155) and 7) Adithya Kiran (25HAVE195009).

The first five candidates brought materials to the examination hall with the intention of copying. The next student was involved in writing the answers in question paper and checking the answers with the intention of copying. The last one was involved in taking the record of other student during the exam. The matter was presented to the committee, and the students were called for inquiry.

The cases of the candidates and the recommendations of the examination committee are as follows.

1. On October 15, 2025, Franklin Babu (23UBBA12050) of Semester 5 BBA was reportedly discovered to have written notes in his hand during the Regular Examination for the course 19U5CRBBA19 : Engagement Planning and New

- media. When the candidate was called in for hearing, he agreed that he had written notes in his hand. He wrote a letter to the committee acknowledging this misbehaviour. The committee recommended cancelling only Regular theory examinations of UG Semester 5 October - November 2025 of Franklin Babu (23UBBA12050).
2. It was reported that on October 15, 2025, Thanseem Shihab BBA (23UBBA12047) of Semester 5 BBA had written notes on his body and uniform shirt during the Regular Examination for the Course 19U5CRBBA19 : Engagement Planning and New media. When the candidate was called in for hearing, he agreed that he had written notes in his body and uniform. He wrote a letter to the committee acknowledging this misbehaviour. The committee recommended cancelling only Regular theory examinations of UG Semester 5 October - November 2025 of Thanseem Shihab BBA (23UBBA12047).
 3. Vallabh S Jain (24HEMS14711), of Semester 3 BSc (Hon), was reported to have engaged in malpractice on October 29, 2025, while appearing for the Course 24UEMSDSC202 : Macroeconomic Analysis. He had brought paper with answers written on it. The candidate admitted that he had used a small chit of paper with answers written on it. The committee received a written letter from him admitting this misconduct. The committee recommended cancelling all the UG Semester 3 Regular theory examinations written by the candidate Vallabh S Jain (24HEMS14711) in October - November 2025.
 4. It was reported that Ajith C V (24HCTX14152) of Semester 3 B.Com (Hon), was reported to have engaged in malpractice on October 30, 2025, while appearing for the Course 24UCOMDSC202 – Innovations and Trends in Banking. He had written answers written on hand. The candidate admitted that he had answers written on hand. The committee received a written letter from him admitting this misconduct. Upon being called for a hearing, the candidate agreed that he had written notes on Hall ticket. He admitted this misconduct in a letter that was submitted to the committee. The committee recommended that all the UG Semester 3 Supplementary exams that Muhammed Yaseen T S (23UCTX11518) wrote in October - November 2025 be cancelled.

6. On November 20, 2025, Diya Fathima Vinshad (25HBCA18155) of Semester 1 BCA was reportedly discovered to have written answer codes in the question paper and passed to Devananda P R (25HBCA18117) for checking the answer codes during the practical exam – Programming in C (24UBCADSC101). When the candidates were called in for hearing, Diya Fathima Vinshad agreed that she had written answer codes in the question paper and passed to Devananda P R for checking the answer codes whether it is correct or not. She wrote a letter to the committee acknowledging this misbehaviour. The committee recommended cancelling only Regular practical examinations of UG Semester 1 October - November 2025 of Diya Fathima Vinshad (25HBCA18155). Devananda P R agreed that she had received the question paper. The committee recommended giving a warning to Devananda P R (25HBCA18117).
7. It was reported that on November 21, 2025, Adithya Kiran (25HAVE195009) of BA Animation and Visual Effects of Semester 1 had allegedly taken the record book of another student, renamed it and submitted during the Regular Viva Examination for the MDC Course 24UVICMDC101: Experiencing Cinema. When the candidate was called in for hearing, he agreed that he had taken the record of other student. He wrote a letter to the committee acknowledging this misbehaviour. The committee recommended cancelling all the examinations of UG Semester 1 November 2025 & UG Semester 2 April 2026 of Adithya Kiran (25HAVE195009). The committee also recommend that Aditya Kiran should not be allowed to attend the sem 2 classes. If he is interested to continue studies in this college, he can rejoin from Semester 3 on a regular basis, 2026- 27 academic year.

The Principal accepted the recommendations of the Examination Committee subject to the approval of the Governing Body.

The Governing Body approved and ratified the actions taken by the Principal in this regard.

No. 1836/2019/HEDN dated 17.10.2019) for enhancement of all fees, including tuition fees, hostel fees, University fees etc. of all the students Studying in Government/Aided Arts & Science colleges under the control of Director of Collegiate Education by 5% from 2019 and thereafter every year.
