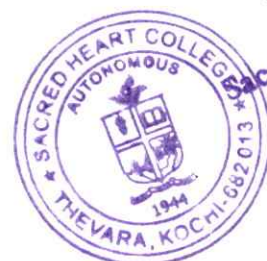

Agenda Item No. 2: Reporting of the college activities by the Principal

Fr.(Dr.) Jose John, Principal of the college, informed the meeting that as per the decision of the last Governing Body meeting, the college applied to the MG University for starting seven new programmes from 2022-23 academic year onwards. But the University rejected the application on the basis of the clarification obtained from the Government in starting new self-financing programmes in aided/autonomous colleges. So the college has filed a writ in the High Court against the University decision. He also mentioned about the NAAC Re-accreditation visit held on 27th and 28th January. He said that classes are going on smoothly and examinations could be conducted successfully even in the threat of covid -19 pandemic.

Government of Kerala has given sanction (G.O (Rt.) No. 1836/2019/HEDN dated 17.10.2019) for enhancement of all fees, including tuition fees, hostel fees, University fees etc. of all the students Studying in Government/Aided Arts & Science colleges under the control of Director of Collegiate Education by 5% from 2019 and thereafter every year.

But, due to the covid-19 pandemic, we have decreased the fees during the years 2020-21 and 2021-22.

Now, by considering various aspects, the Finance Committee resolved to recommend to the Governing Body to take steps to increase all fees by 5% with effect from 2022-23 academic year onwards.

The governing body approved the budget for the year 2022-23 and accepted the Finance committee proposal to increase the fees of various programmes

Agenda Item No. 5: Reporting of Academic Council decisions

As part of the proposed UG syllabus revision which will be effective from 2023-24 admissions onwards, the Academic council which met on 17th March 2022 approved the **‘REGULATIONS FOR CHOICE BASED CREDIT AND SEMESTER SYSTEM (CBCSS) FOR UNDER GRADUATE PROGRAMMES -2023’**. Also, the academic council approved the suggestions of the various Boards of Studies in connection with the Syllabus revision.

The Governing Body requested the Academic Council and various Boards of studies to take necessary steps to revise the syllabus as per the IQAC directions.

Agenda Item No. 6: Admission Prospectus for the Academic Year 2022-23

The Academic council meeting on 17th March approved the decision of the admission committee to follow the admission prospectus of the last year (2021-22) for the year 2022-23 admissions also.

Agenda Item No. 7: Proposals from the Controller of Examinations

At present, double valuation is the mode of valuation of answer scripts of PG examinations. The valuation is done by an internal examiner and an external examiner. Our University already adopted single valuation for PG examinations. The examination committee, by considering the various aspects of valuation, proposed single valuation of answer scripts of PG examinations from 2021 admissions onwards. The Academic council meeting on 17th March approved the decision of the Examination committee.
