Fr. Varghese Kachappilly CMI, the Manager of the College presided over the meeting which started at 3.00 PM with a silent prayer. Principal, Dr. C.S.Biju welcomed all the members to the meeting.

Reporting of the college activities by the Principal

Principal, Dr. Biju C.S. informed the meeting the following:

- Our college placed in the 44th position in NIRF ranking and 3rd position in Kerala
- The college bagged the third position in the M.G. University Youth Festival
- Two new programmes, namely BSW(Hons) and MSc Psychology started in this academic year
- Created a history in students enrolment with 3690 students in the roll.
- College was selected as the best sports college by the MG University
- The number of Phd^s produced crossed the milestone 150
- College Union Election conducted very smoothly
- A meeting of the Academic Council held on 18th September 2025

The Governing Body congratulated the Management, Principal, Staff and students for being the 3rd in the NIRF ranking, 3rd in the University Youth Festival and the best sports college under the Mahatma Gandhi University. Even though, the number of students enrolment recorded a history, the Governing Body observed a significant decrease in the admission of certain programmes and decided to cease such programmes if the trend continues.

Agenda Item No.1: Minutes (already circulated) of the meeting of the Governing Body held on 20.03.2025 and discussion on items arising out of the minutes.

The Governing Body approved the minutes of the meeting held on 20.03.2025

Agenda Item No. 2: Reporting of the Academic Council decisions

The following are the important decisions taken by the Academic Council which met on 18th September 2025.

- (i) The Academic Council accepted the proposal of the Board of Studies(BoS) in Aquaculture and Fish Processing to cease the self-financing MSc programme in Aquaculture and Fish Processing and to start a new Honours programme, namely, **BSc (Hons) Aquaculture**. The MG University syllabus is recommended as the syllabus of the programme.

(ii) The Academic Council accepted the proposal of the Board of Studies (BoS) in Commerce to restructure the B.Com (Hons.) Computer Applications to **B.Com (Hons.) FinTech and Digital Finance**. The Academic Council also accepted the proposal of the Board of Studies (BoS) in Commerce to change the nomenclature of B.Com (Hons.) Travel and Tourism to **B.Com (Hons.) Global Trade and Tourism Management**.

(iii) The BoS of Management Studies proposed a new programme, namely, **BBA(Hons) Logistics and Supply Chain Management** and a certificate course, namely, Post Graduate Certificate in Management with specialisation in Business Analytics abbreviated as PGCM (Business Analytics). The Academic Council decided to recommend the proposal to the Governing Body.

The Governing Body accepted the Academic Council decisions and decided to

- (i) to cease the self-financing MSc programme in Aquaculture and Fish Processing and to start a new Honours programme, namely, **BSc (Hons) Aquaculture**. The MG University syllabus shall be taken as the syllabus of the new programme. The intake of the programme is fixed as 40.
- (ii) to restructure the B.Com (Hons.) Computer Applications to **B.Com (Hons.) FinTech and Digital Finance** and to change the nomenclature of B.Com (Hons.) Travel and Tourism to **B.Com (Hons.) Global Trade and Tourism Management**.
- (iii) to start a new programme, namely, **BBA(Hons) Logistics and Supply Chain Management** with 40 seats.
- (iv) to start a certificate course, namely, Post Graduate Certificate in Management with specialisation in Business Analytics, abbreviated as PGCM (Business Analytics).
- (v) to start a new PG programme in Social Work with 30 seats

The Governing Body approved the results and ratified the publication of the results.

The Governing Body also expressed its concern over the pass percentages of the UG semester examinations, especially, the results of the students of the departments of Botany and Zoology. The Governing Body urged all the teachers to take remedial measures to improve the results in examinations.

The Governing Body also decided to constitute a committee consisting of the Principal, the IQAC Co-ordinator, the Manager or his representative and one senior Faculty Member to assess the performance of the teachers in every three years (first assessment after two years of appointment).

Agenda Item No. 4: Examination Malpractice cases

The Examination Committee considered malpractice cases of 12 students reported during the even semester examination of 2024-25. The candidates are Haripriya C P (24HPHY13728), Yasir Bin Yoosaf BCA (24HBCA14418), Samuel Sam John (24PEVS16707), Nihal Vezhavelil Sathar (23UCCA11858), Nkuruniziza Delphin (24HBCA14452), Akhilesh S (24HCAP14512), Abdullah Khalid Mohammed (24HBCA14453), Riya Suresh Kumar (21UPSY1526 - 2024 passout), Teswin Shajan (20UCCA4824), Abel M Paulose (23UBBA13224), Alan K A (23UBCA11311) and George Salvio (22UMCP8112). They are all found bringing materials to the examination hall with the intention of copying. The matter was presented to the committee, and the students were called for inquiry.

1. On April 26, 2025, Haripriya C P (24HPHY13728) of Semester 2 BSc (Hons) Physics was reportedly discovered to have committed academic dishonesty during her Physics practical exam. She was carrying a paper with answers in it. When the candidate was called in for hearing, she agreed that she had brought the documents though she denied having written anything from it. She wrote a letter to the committee acknowledging this misbehaviour. The committee recommended cancelling only Regular practical examinations of UG Semester 2 March-April 2025 of Haripriya C P (24HPHY13728).
2. It was reported that on April 15, 2025, Yasir Bin Yoosaf BCA (24HBCA14418) of Semester 2 BCA (Hons) Mobile Applications and Cloud Technology (SF) was hiding a mobile phone in his pocket during the Regular Examination for the

Course 24UBCADCC104 : Statistical Methods for Computational Analysis. This is the second time he was carrying the mobile phone. When the candidate was called in for hearing, he agreed bringing mobile phone. He wrote a letter to the committee acknowledging this misbehaviour. The committee recommended to cancel UG Semester 2 Regular theory Examinations only, March-April 2025 of Yasir Bin Yoosaf BCA (24HBCA14418). Confiscated mobile phone shall be returned along with memo.

3. Samuel Sam John (24PEVS16707) of Semester 2 (MSc Environmental Studies - SF), was reported to have engaged in malpractice on April 4, 2025, while appearing for the Course 24P2EVST06: Disaster Management. He was found scribbling on the desk before the exams which was caught on camera. Upon examining his seat, it was found that he had written something on his leg. The candidate was summoned for hearing, and he admitted that he had written on the desk as well as on his leg. The committee received a written letter from him admitting this misconduct. The committee recommended cancelling all the PG Semester 2 Regular theory Examinations only written by the candidate Samuel Sam John (24PEVS16707) in March-April 2025.
4. It was reported that Nihal Vezhavelil Sathar (23UCCA11858) of B.Com Computer Application (SF), was reported to have engaged in malpractice on March 28, 2025, while appearing for the Course 19U4CRCOM13 - Capital Market. He had brought paper with answers written on it. The candidate admitted that he had used a small chit of paper with answers written on it. The committee received a written letter from him admitting this misconduct. The committee recommended cancelling all the UG Semester 4 Regular theory examinations written by the candidate (Nihal Vezhavelil Sathar 23UCCA11858) in March-April 2025.
5. It was reported that on April 16, 2025, Nkuruniziza Delphin (24HBCA14452) of Semester 2 BCA was found to commit a malpractice when taking exam for the course 24UBCASEC102: Linux Operating System. When he showed up for the exam, he was discovered copying answers from a bit of paper with answers written in it. Upon being called for a hearing, the candidate agreed that he had used a small bit of paper with answers written on it. He admitted this misconduct

in a letter that was submitted to the committee. The committee recommended that all the UG Semester 2 Regular theory exams that Nkuruniziza Delphin (24HBCA14452), wrote in March-April 2025 be cancelled.

6. On April 11, 2025, Akhilesh S (24HCAP14512) of Semester 2 BSc (Hons) Computer Applications (SF) was found cheating during his exam appearance for the course 24UCAPDSC102 OOPS with C++. He had brought small bit paper with answers writing on it. When the candidate was called in for a hearing, he agreed that, he had brought small bits of paper. He wrote a letter to the committee acknowledging this misbehaviour. The committee recommended that UG Semester 2 Regular theory examinations of Akhilesh S (24HCAP14512) March - April 2025 be cancelled.
7. Abdullah Khalid Mohammed (24HBCA14453) of Semester 2 BCA (Hons) Mobile Applications and Cloud Technology (SF) was hiding a mobile phone in his pocket on April 16, 2025 while appearing for the UG Sem 2 Regular examination for the course 24UBCASEC102 : Linuz Operating System. When the candidate was called in for hearing, he agreed bringing mobile phone. He wrote a letter to the committee acknowledging this misbehaviour. The committee received a written letter from him admitting this misconduct. The committee recommended giving a warning to the candidate under the condition that if it is repeated, then that exams will be cancelled. Confiscated mobile phone shall be returned along with memo.
8. It was reported that Riya Suresh Kumar (21UPSY1526) was found to engage in malpractice on April 28, 2025 while appearing for the UG Sem 2 Supplementary examination for the course 19U2CCHIN2A : Translation, Correspondence and Applied Grammar. She was found scribbling on her left foot with answers written. The candidate was summoned for hearing, and she admitted that she had written answers in her leg. The committee received a written letter from her admitting this misconduct. The committee recommended cancelling all the UG Semester 2 Supplementary theory examinations written by the candidate (Riya Suresh Kumar 21UPSY1526) in March-April 2025.

9. Teswin Shajan (20UCCA4824) was found to engage in malpractice on April 21, 2025 while appearing for the UG Sem 2 Supplementary examination for the course 19U2CRCOM08 – Business Communication and Management Information. He had brought small bit paper with answers writing on it. He wrote a letter to the committee acknowledging this misbehaviour. The committee recommended cancelling all the UG Semester 2 Supplementary theory examinations written by the candidate, Teswin Shajan (20UCCA4824 - Passout) in March-April 2025.
10. Abel M Paulose (23UBBA13224) of Semester 4 BBA (Business Analytics – SF) was hiding a mobile phone in his pocket on April 10, 2025 while appearing for the UG Sem 2 Supplementary examination for the course 19U2CCENG03 – Text and Context : A Guide to Effective Reading and Writing. He wrote a letter to the committee acknowledging this misbehaviour. The committee received a written letter from him admitting this misconduct. The committee recommended cancelling all the UG Semester 2 Supplementary theory examinations written by the candidate, Abel M Paulose (23UBBA13224) in March-April 2025. Confiscated mobile phone shall be returned along with memo.
11. Alan K A (23UBCA11311) was found to engage in malpractice on March 26, 2025 while appearing for the UG Sem 4 Regular examination for the course 19U4CRBCA12 – Web Technologies. 12. George Salvio (22UMCP8112) was found to engage in malpractice on March 25, 2025 while appearing for the UG Sem 6 Regular examination for the course 21UP6CRMCP18 –Linux and Shell Programming. He had written answers on the hall ticket. He wrote a letter to the committee acknowledging this misbehaviour. The committee recommended cancelling all the UG Semester 6 Regular theory examinations written by the candidate, George Salvio (22UMCP8112) in March-April 2025.

The Principal accepted the recommendations of the Examination Committee subject to the approval of the Governing Body.

The Governing Body approved and ratified the actions taken by the Principal in this regard.
