The seventh Board of Studies meeting of the department of Botany, St College, Thevara started by 11.00 am, 22nd July 2017 with a silent prayer. Dr. Fr. Jose John, Hon and Chairman of the BOS presided over the meeting. Ten BOS members were present during the meeting.

Dr. Fr. Jose John welcomed and explained the agenda of the meeting. Dr. Giby Kurialose, Secretary, BOS presented reports of the 5th and 6th BOS meetings.

He then introduced the new BOS member Dr. Malher Dan (Scientist E1, JNTBGRI) to the members of the BOS.

Major Resolutions of the meeting are as follows

1. The meeting discussed the need, possibilities and challenges of revising the UG syllabus in light of completion of 3 years after the revision of BSc Botany syllabus
2. BOS decided to entrust course teachers to come up with suggestions and modifications, if any, on the existing BSc Syllabus
3. The BOS compared and discussed over the revised syllabus of MG university with that of BSc Botany St College, Thevara
4. The BOS suggested to get feed back from students

- on the ongoing syllabus for each course per semester
5. It also suggested to get feed back on Hands on training program of final year BSc Botany.
 6. The BOS discussed ~~on~~ the existing PG syllabus in light of the feed back from IIIrd Semester PG students based on PG 1st and IInd semester and decided to continue with the revised syllabus since it is not logical to come to conclusions.
 7. The BOS discussed whether spreading of each subjects at least in 5th and 6th semester UG programme, to 2 semesters instead of one semester and suggested to find out the feasibility of the same.

Resolution:

The BOS unanimously resolved to suggest an increase in the sanctioned strength by 30% for UG programme. The meeting came to an end by 3:20pm
