
















The meeting began with a silent prayer. Dr. Cherian P. E., Chairman BOS in Economics presented agenda of the meeting. The meeting deliberated on the structure, composition and content of revised syllabus of Puz programme in Economics of our College. The meeting resolved the following.

- 1) To have 16 core papers and four optional (Elective) papers - 1 optional paper in the third semester and three optional papers in the fourth semester, a short dissertations cum viva as twenty first paper and a general viva as twenty second paper of the Puz course structure.

2) To have following optional papers in the third and fourth semesters.

3) To have guided field survey/Internship for students during two-month vacation (April-May) after the second semester of P.W. programme. It is a desirable/optional course and students spending 40 hours in any one of these programmes will be awarded

two additional credits. Students are required to prepare a short report on the details and outcome of the survey / details and outcome of internship.

4) To request the course teacher of "Quantitative Methods for Economic Analysis" to include a chapter on methods of data collection, sampling, data classification etc which will impart sufficient knowledge and skill to students to conduct field survey.

5) To approve the revised syllabus 16 core papers and four elective papers and guidelines for project cum viva and general viva.
