The details of the discussions and resolutions taken at the meeting are given below.

- ① The meeting resolved:
- a. To introduce one more additional choice based course "Introductory Econometrics" to the existing choice based elective course of "Human Resource Management" in the 6th semester of BA Economics programme from academic year 2017-18.
 - b. Students of 2017-20, 2016-19, and 2015-18 BA Economics batches can

choose one of these choice based electives in the 6th semester of their degree programme.

c. The meeting resolved to follow the syllabus of a core course (No. 10, Sem V) "Introductory Econometrics" in the BA Economics programme of M. U. University introduced from 2017 admission as the syllabus for choice based elective course "Introductory Econometrics" in the BA Economics programme of Sacred Heart College, Thiruvana, for the above mentioned batches.

2. It was resolved in the meeting to revise the syllabus of BA Economics programme to be introduced from 2018-19 admission. Meeting proposed and discussed courses of the programme. Various committees were constituted at department level and requested these committees to examine the relevance of the proposed courses in the changing economic scenario and also to examine whether these courses are able to produce qualified labour force that meets demands of industry, commerce, business, academics and research, and propose newer courses if any proposed courses were found unfit. Committees were requested to prepare syllabus for the proposed courses and circulate course syllabus among members of Board of Studies for their comments and suggestions.

3. The meeting proposed to request M. U. University for a marginal increase


of 10% of sanctioned strength of BA and MA Economics programme.


