1	The curriculum is not appropriate for the students to address issues such as gender equality, environment and sustainability, ethics and other values.	Environmental science course has been revised. Ethical issues are discussed in the Research methodology and Biotechnology courses
2	The electives offered are not relevant to the core subject and are not useful for the specialisation of the subject.	The elective courses are offered in the fourth semester. The biotechnology and related course are offered.
3	The syllabus is not appropriate for the programme and does not include the recent advancements in the subject.	A recent and advanced topic has been included in Molecular biology, Cell biology, Biotechnology and Genetics.
4	The laboratory experiments are not enough to enhance the understanding of the concepts and do not promote experimental learning.	Unnecessary experiments have been removed from the syllabus and new experiments or practical has been introduced.
5	The curriculum designed for the programme does not encourage extra learning or self-learning.	The new curriculum gives importance to assignments and seminars which encourages students to learn outside the syllabus and acquire extra knowledge.
6	The learning objectives of each course in the syllabus are not well defined.	The learning objectives, course outcomes and programme outcomes are clearly defined in the new syllabus.
