


STUDENTS' CURRICULUM FEEDBACK ANALYSIS REPORT

Student Feedback Analysis



(a) Our concerns in the order of priority:-

- Q10: The curriculum introduces students to issue such as gender equality, environment and sustainability, ethics and other values (81.8%)
- Q9: The curriculum is designed to develop ability to analyse real life issues. (72.8%)
- Q6: The electives offered are relevant to the core subject and are useful for the specialisation of a subject domain. (63.6%)

- The syllabus is appropriate for the programme and includes the recent Q2: advancements in the subject (59.1%)
- The difficult level of the syllabus is fair (54.5%) Q3:
- The laboratory experiments are designed to enhance the understanding of the Q11: concepts and promote experimental learning. (31.7%)
- The curriculum designed for the programme encourages extra learning /self Q5: Learning (45.5%)
- The curriculum sufficiently motivates for further study and research (59.9%) Q7:
- The Learning objectives of each course in the syllabus are well defined and clear Q1: (40.9%)

(b) Suggestions for curriculum improvement from students:-

- 1. Internship/project should be at minimum of 2 months outside the college.
- 2. Need to remove unwanted topics.
- 3. Syllabus should be organized, remove unwanted topics, add recent topics.
- 4. Recent and advancing topics has to be included in the subject.

5. Need to improve unwanted topics.
