Communication is the act of transferring information from one place, person or group to another. Every communication involves one sender, message and a recipient.

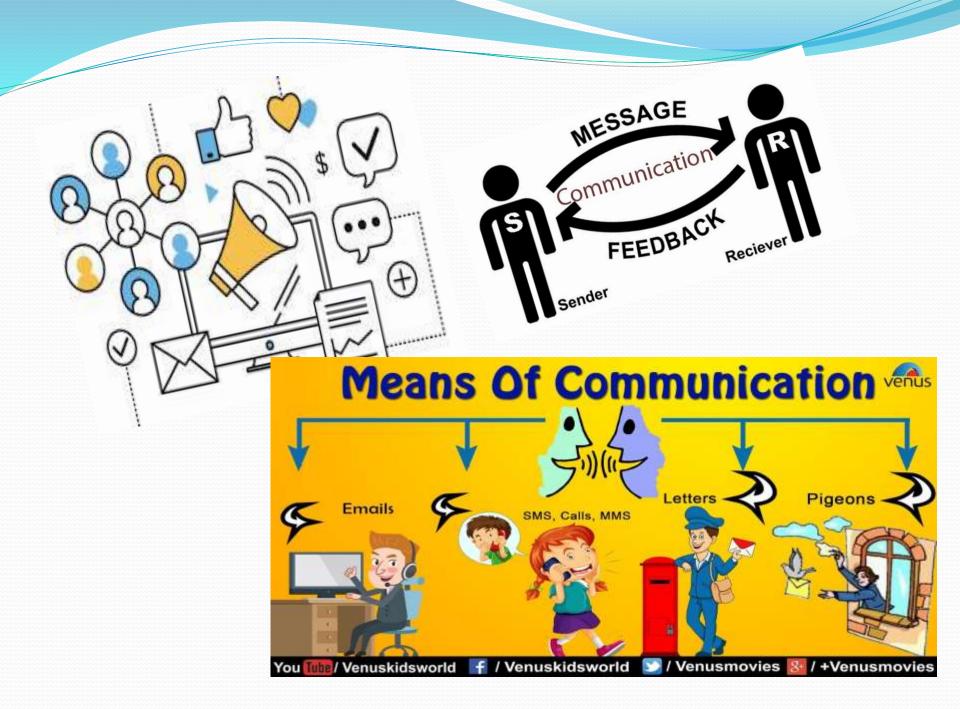
### **NEEDS OF COMMUNICATION:**
