



## What is Enlightenment?



## Age of Enlightenment

- It was a philosophical movement which dominated the world of ideas in the 18th century.
  - The principal goals of this period were liberty,progress,reason,tolerance,fraternity and ending the abuses of the Church and the State.



Immanuel Kant
 (1724-1804) was a
 German philosopher
 who was considered
 as the central figure
 of modern philosophy.

 Kant's essay addresses the causes for lack of enlightenment and the preconditions necessary for people to enlighten themselves.

 It is necessary for people to throw away their spoon-fed dogmas and formulas that they have absorbed so that they are intellectually autonomous.  This essay was published in 1784 by philosopher Immanuel Kant as an answer to the question posed by Reverend Johann Friedrich Zollner.

In this essay Kant says that lack of enlightenment is not lack of intellect but lack of courage.



## Philosopher Immanuel Kant

"Enlightenment is man's emergence from his selfincurred immaturity. Immaturity is the inability to use one's own understanding without the guidance of another. This immaturity is self-incurred if its cause is not lack of understanding, but lack of resolution and courage to use it without the guidance of another. The motto of enlightenment is therefore: Sapere aude! Have courage to use your own understanding!"



"All our knowledge begins with the senses, proceeds then to the understanding, and ends with reason.

- Kant says that majority of the people of the society are content to follow the guiding institutions of the society like the Church and the Monarchy.
