What is Visual Effects (VFX)?

VFX is the integration between actual footage and this manipulated imagery to create realistic looking environments for the context. These environments created are either too dangerous to actually shoot, or worlds that just don't exist. They use computergenerated imagery (CGI), and particular VFX software to make it happen.

FILM PROCESS

Pre-production

- The idea for a film is developed
- scripts are written (and re-written!)
- budgets and timelines are determined
- financing is secured
- actors and locations are sourced.

Production

The filming takes place on set (can be on location, or in a studio with sets and/or green screens)

Post-production

- Visual effects
- Sound
- Editing
- Color grading
- Distribution.
