Subject:- Raman Fellowship for Post Docotoral Research for Indian Scholars in United States for the Year 2014-15 to be awarded by University Grants Commission.

Madam / Sir,

With reference to your application on the subject cited above, I am pleased to inform you that the UGC has awarded you Raman Post Doctoral Fellowship for the year 2014-15 in USA for a period of 12 months with the following terms & conditions:

- The fellow will be entitled to fellowship amount of US \$ 3000 per month.
- The fellow will also be entitled to one time personal contingency grant of up to a maximum of Rs. 50,000 to cover for visa, airport transfer, medical insurance etc.
- ❖ Fellow will also be permitted to travel within USA to attend conferences or other institutes of interest with the approval of the advisor at the host institute.
- The fellow will be entitled to avail one of the following grants for this purpose:
- I. Grant of \$ 600 for fellowship period up to 6 months.
- II. Grant of \$ 1200 for fellowship period beyond 6 months.

The UGC letter no. 1-6-2012 (PS) dated 7th June, 2013 may be referred to regarding the grant of study leave to university and college teachers.

Rules governing payment of salary, Study leave, medical, gratuity, GPF and Pension etc. of the organization / institution / university to which the fellow belongs would continue to be applicable. No liability on any of these accounts will be borne by UGC.

Air -tickets for the selected fellow would be purchased by the respective university / institution by economy class for shortest route from their place of work in India to the place of the American host institute and back. The actual ticket amount would be reimbursed by UGC to the institution for the same on submission of all relevant document duly certified by the competent authority of the institution.

The candidate selected for the award for this fellowship should commence their research within six month period from the date of award announcement. Failure to do so would render the fellow to forfeit the award.

You are requested to convey your acceptance towards the award and also send your tentative tour programme to the UGC duly countersigned and stamped by the University / College to enable the Commission to obtain Political Clearance from Ministry of External Affairs. However your visit to USA will be subject to political clearance from Ministry of External Affairs.

The mandate form from your University / College to claim the fellowship amount should be sent to the UGC Office along with the acceptance letter at the earliest. A performa for submitting report by the scholar on his/her visit is also enclosed. The scholar should submit the report in the prescribed performa within 90 days after the completion of his/her research work in USA.
