GENERAL COLLABORATIVE AGREEMENT BETWEEN
JUNIATA COLLEGE, HUNTINGDON, PENNSYLVANIA, USA
AND
SACRED HEART COLLEGE, THEVARA, KOCHI, INDIA
JANUARY 2013

PARTIES INVOLVED

Dr. Thomas R. Kepple, representing Juniata College
in accordance with the authority conferred upon him,

and

Dr. Fr. J. Palakkappillil CMI, Principal, representing Sacred Heart College
in accordance with the authority conferred upon him,

DECLARE

that it is the desire of both institutions to draw up a general collaborative agreement. The agreement will serve to establish an appropriate legal and institutional framework to promote academic activities and joint research in areas of interest to both institutions.

This agreement will be governed by the following:

CLAUSES

I. Juniata College and Sacred Heart College will foster collaboration between the two institutions to develop joint activities in the areas of:

- *Academic courses*
- *The exchange of students and faculty*
- *Coordination of research projects and the development of technology*
- *Outreach and service to deserving groups and communities*


II. Juniata College and Sacred Heart College will exchange the necessary information to determine the specific areas of study where there is interest in developing joint projects.

III. This agreement will be carried out by adhering to a specific agreement, which will be drawn up by the parties that sign this general agreement. Those parties will in turn designate those responsible for carrying out the more specific agreement.

- IV. The selection of joint activities will be carried out based on mutually agreed upon criteria and joint effort.
- V. The chief international officers of each institution will oversee relations concerning further cooperation between the two institutions.
- VI. The present agreement will be in effect for two years, with the option to extend, unless one of the parties decides not to renew at least 90 days prior to the renewal date.
- VII. The resolution of possible conflicts concerning the interpretation or execution of the present General Agreement will be handled by an Arbitration Committee formed by a member designated by each of the parties involved and a member elected by mutual agreement. In absence of such a member, the Commission will be selected from a group of people designated equally by each party.

As proof of agreement of both parties, this agreement shall be signed in duplicate by both parties.
