




- A Auckland University of Technology is a statutory body corporate established by Order-In-Council under the Education Act 1989, the principal campus of which is located at Wellesley Street, Auckland, (AUT).
- B Sacred Heart College, Thevara, Kochi, is a premier institution of higher education affiliated to the Mahatma Gandhi University, Kerala, India. Established in 1944 by the Carmelites of Mary Immaculate (CMI), and accredited by the National Accreditation and Assessment Council (NAAC) at the A+ level, (SHC).
- C AUT is engaged in the provision of higher education programmes to specified standards which are provided in accordance with specific course regulations, utilising and comprising certain techniques. Such techniques include curriculum development, assessment, evaluation, validation and review, learning materials, management methods and standard operational procedures. It has expended substantial time, effort and money in the same.
- D SHC is engaged in the provision of educational programmes in accordance with specific course regulations, utilising and comprising certain techniques. Such techniques include curriculum development, assessment, evaluation, validation and review, learning materials, management methods and standard operational procedures. It has expended substantial time, effort and money in the development and implementation of the same.
- E AUT and SHC recognise the benefits to be derived from co-operating and collaborating each with the other in the provision of the specified programmes and each acknowledges the necessity of conforming to the high standards required in the provision of the programmes.
- F AUT and SHC agree to collaborate in the provision of higher education programmes by SHC that may lead to academic awards of AUT.
- G By signing this agreement, which comprises this page and the attached terms and Schedules

(Agreement). the University and the Colleges agree to the matters set out in it.

IT IS HEREBY AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

1 DEFINITIONS

THE PROGRAMME(S) means the courses, programmes, programme modules and awards prescribed in Schedule 1 of this Agreement

THE MAIN PURPOSES means the development, teaching and execution of the Programmes

AUT REGULATIONS means AUT Regulations published by AUT in the AUT Academic Calendar and in current use during the course of the relevant academic year.

The Parties understand and accept that it is a fundamental term of this Agreement that:

- The development, teaching and execution of the Programmes must be in accordance with the prevailing AUT General Academic Statute and any other relevant University documentation.
- Unless the context dictates otherwise the use of the singular shall include the plural and the use of the plural shall include the singular.
- Neither Party shall be the agent of the other and a legal partnership is not created by way of this Agreement.

2. DURATION

2.1 Commencement and Term

This Agreement shall commence on the date that the last party signing entered on this Agreement (the *Date*) and shall continue in force for three years from the *Date* unless terminated in accordance with this clause.

2.2 Termination

- At any time during this Agreement, either Party may terminate it by giving not less than one year's written notice to the other.
- In the event that one Party (*the Defaulting Party*):
