REPORT

Background

The acronym **MOODLE** officially stands for modular object-oriented dynamic learning environment, is a free and open-source learning management system (LMS). It is used for blended learning, distance education, flipped classroom and other e-learning projects in schools, universities, workplaces and other sectors. Moodle's modular nature and inherent flexibility make it an ideal platform for academic level applications. The IQAC of Sacred Heart College organized a five day faculty training program on **MOODLE LMS** during 11-15 May, 2015 in the Chavara IT Centre of the College. The aim of the programme was to equip teachers to create and deliver personalized learning environments through a free and open source learning management system – MOODLE.

Inaugural Session

The program started with a silent invocation. Dr. Joseph T Moolayil, IQAC coordinator of Sacred Heart College, Thevara welcomed the participants and the resource person, Mr. Biju V. V. Technical session

- Create Assignment
- Add questions in the question bank and Conduct a quiz / exam in the Moodle

He also urged the participants to explore the other plugins in the moodle page in every possible manner to make the courses more appealing. In the final session the participants shared their views and comments about the program.

Finally in the concluding session, on behalf of the faculty members Dr. Ramakrishnan S, Assistant Professor, Department of Chemistry, Sacred Heart College, Thevara congratulated the IQAC for organizing the program and proposed vote of thanks to the resource person and organizing committee.
