REPORT

Green protocol is essentially a set of measures which when implemented results in significant reduction of waste. The primary focus is on waste minimization through prevention of use of disposables and using reusable alternatives like glass/stainless/porcelain cutleries. In line with this movement, the IQAC of Sacred Heart College, Thevara organized an orientation program for the faculty members and administrative staffs of the college on Green Protocol on July 17th, 2015.

IQAC coordinator of Sacred Heart College, Thevara Dr. Joseph T Moolayil welcomed the participants and the resource person. He introduced the participants about the importance of conducting the program. The resource persons for the program was Rev. Fr. Prasant Palackappillil CMI, Principal, Sacred Heart College.

Fr. Prashant gave a deep analysis into the problem of Solid Waste Management and mentioned that waste started becoming an unmanageable problem hardly ten to fifteen years back at the most and the reason for that narrows down to one word "Disposables". He urged the members of Sacred Heart College to avoid the use of all types of disposables (including plastic, paper) in daily life. Avoid banned plastic materials and follow government rules in this regard. He instructed the faculty members to make sure to use cloth banners instead of flex for all the department and college programs. Always use eco-friendly materials like leaves flowers etc for decoration and while making bouquets for felicitating guests. Finally he pointed that waste reduction occupies the top position in the waste management hierarchy and the Green Protocol's methodology is focused on the prevention of waste generation. More importantly, implementing the Green Protocol could save money as well as the resources.

The participants took a pledge to make the campus of Sacred Heart College a green zone. The participants congratulated the IQAC for taking initiatives to organize the program and shared their views about reducing the solid waste in the college. The program concluded with a vote of thanks by the IQAC joint coordinator, Dr. K. M. Johnson.

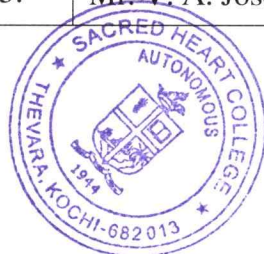


