

### **REPORT**

Open Educational Resources (OER) is becoming an important factor in achieving quality education to a larger community. The use of OERs holds great promise of improving the access to and the overall quality of education for the developed as well as the developing countries. The tutors are creating and using digital content for teaching and learning. The access to quality content is possible only for those who attend higher education institutions or those who can afford to purchase the instructional material. The OER movement aims to make this content available for free use for enhancing educational opportunities for hitherto unreached sections of the society thus leading to equalizing of access. OERs can play a vital role in the existing scenario of distance learning by improving quality, access, reach and also providing competitive edge and recognition globally. In view of this IQAC of Sacred heart College, Thevara organized a workshop on **Open Educational Resources** on 16th January, 2015 at Marian Hall of the college. The workshop aims at discussing various opportunities and challenges offered by the use of OERs in the education system.

### **Inaugural Session**

The program started with a silent prayer. Dr. K.M Johnson, IQAC coordinator of Sacred Heart College, Thevara welcomed the participants and the resource person. He introduced the resource person and spoke about the importance of this workshop for the academic community. Rev. Fr.
