- 8. Conversion rate of US Dollar into Indian Currency from (any bank/or other financial Institution).
- 9. Copies of the ticket travelled abroad from the airport to the venue of the conference and back alongwith boarding passes.
- 10. E-ticket is acceptable provided the amount or the fare is clearly reflected on the ticket.
- 11. Certificate from Air India as a proof of shortest route with economy class return excursion air fare for the journey.
- 12. Visa fee receipt as per embassy rate.
- 13. As the grants to the colleges are to be sent electronically only, therefore it is requested that details of Bank Account number of **Principal/Director/Dean** may be sent to UGC in the enclosed mandate form.
