

Bloom's Taxonomy is a hierarchical ordering of cognitive skills that can, among countless other uses, help teachers teach and students learn. Many educators love Bloom's taxonomy because, among other virtues, it gives them a way to think about their teaching—and the subsequent learning of their students. Bloom's Taxonomy is a tier model of classifying thinking according to 6 cognitive domains. Each level has action verbs associated with the domain. The Taxonomy has been used as a guideline for creating objectives which show evidence of thinking skills beginning at the Lower Order Thinking Skills to the Higher Order Thinking Skills. In view of this the IQAC of Sacred Heart College, Thevara organized a training program on Bloom's taxonomy on 15th September, 2015.

The program started with a silent prayer. Joint coordinator of IQAC, Sacred Heart College, Thevara welcomed the participants and the resource person. He introduced the resource person to the participants and mentioned about the program. Rev. Fr. Prashant Palackappillil CMI, Principal, Sacred Heart College inaugurated the program and delivered the inaugural address. The resource person for the program was Dr. K. M. Johnson, IQAC Jt. coordinator, Sacred Heart College, Thevara.

In the technical session, Dr. Johnson explained about the historical aspects of Bloom's taxonomy. He then discussed the Benjamin Bloom's six levels of learning in a very interesting manner. In his lecture he presented a Power Point Presentation prepared specially for the requirement of the college keeping in mind the six levels of Learning according to Bloom's Taxonomy. During the session he made the participants to frame questions as sample on all six levels so that teachers can also use the same methodology in the classroom situation.

In the final session the participants congratulated the IQAC for taking initiatives to organize the program and shared their views about the program. Mrs. Agile Joy, IQAC Convener on behalf of all the participants proposed vote of thanks.

Faculty Training on Mentoring

Background

Teaching at the collegiate level is a wonderful yet complex career. The faculty members are expected to be organized, teach effectively, research thoroughly, write lucidly, publish often, serve as effective committee members, and maybe even serve as successful administrators. Every new faculty hire has the potential to become a better teacher, researcher, writer, and administrator. Helping them reach their potential is the great challenge of creating and maintaining an effective mentoring program. Because effective mentoring increases the likelihood that faculty members will be successful, designing and implementing a robust mentoring program is an essential part of a faculty development program. The IQAC of Sacred Heart College, Thevara organized a training program for the faculty members on Mentoring on December 10th, 2015.

Dr. K.M Johnson, IQAC Jt. coordinator of Sacred Heart College, Thevara welcomed the participants and the resource person. The resource persons for the program Rev. Fr. Prashant Palackappillil CMI, Principal, Sacred Heart College, Thevara

In the technical session, Fr. Prashant mentioned that most often, the faculty members may not have received formal training in mentorship or they mentor students based on their teaching experience. Therefore, the training of faculty on mentorship will not only enhance faculty's knowledge and skills in mentorship but also ensure the quality of the mentorship provided to the students which is among the prime requirements for the growth of the institution.

He pointed that working with a mentor can be an invaluable experience for both mentor and mentee. They will likely learn new things about themselves and each other that will help them move toward career goals He highlighted the "lack of mentorship" as one of the major barriers to both starting and finishing scholarly projects. During his lecture, Fr. Prashant stressed on the need for a more structured approach to faculty mentoring. He then discussed about the characteristics of effective mentors, maintaining the mentoring relationship and generational issues and mentoring. Finally he conclude his session by mentioned that faculty mentoring influences not just the success of individual faculty, but the intellectual culture and achievement of the entire unit.

In the concluding session the participants congratulated the IQAC for taking initiatives to organize the program and shared their views about the program. The program concluded with a vote of thanks by the IQAC Convener.





Background

A deeper understanding about the process of research is important towards achieving a systematic research. Likewise writing a research paper poses challenges in gathering literature and providing evidence for making your paper stronger. Drawing upon previously established ideas and values and adding pertinent information in your paper are necessary steps, but these need to be done with caution without falling into the trap of plagiarism. Plagiarism is the unethical practice of using words or ideas (either planned or accidental) of another author/researcher or your own previous works without proper acknowledgment. Considered as a serious academic and intellectual offense, plagiarism can result in highly negative consequences such as paper retractions and loss of author credibility and reputation. It is currently a grave problem in academic publishing and a major reason for paper retractions.

As an awareness to the researchers about this the IQAC of Sacred Heart College (Autonomous), Thevara organized a workshop on "Research Process & Plagiarism" on 18th February 2016 at Sacred Heart College (Autonomous), Thevara to offer practical guidelines and direct the researchers through all the stages of research from identifying a research problem to the submission of a dissertation, report writing and research article.

The program started with a silent prayer. Dr. M.S. Francis, HoD of Botany, Sacred Heart College, Thevara welcomed the participants and the resource person. He introduced the resource person and spoke about the importance of this workshop for the research scholars and academic community. Rev. Fr. 

In the era of knowledge-based society, technical education has assumed an indisputable significant role. The new developments in information technologies have opened-up fresh perspectives in teaching and learning. The information and communication technology (ICT) enabled methods shall help the teachers to offer quality e-content; for both - education in classroom and to a larger communities in a structured and interactive way. Hence a proper knowledge on ICT would assist the teachers to improve their quality of teaching and learning processes.

In line with this, IQAC of Sacred Heart College conducted a faculty development program on *ICT – Enabled Teaching* during 23-28 May, 2016 in the College. This FDP was aimed at instilling among the faculty members the benefits of ICT enabled teaching to improve their teaching learning processes.

Inaugural Session

He introduced the resource person and spoke about the circumstance of conducting the program. Rev. In his inaugural address, he mentioned that the increasing use of ICT in all aspects of modern life has led to the concept of a knowledge-based society, one aspect of which is the knowledge-based economy. He pointed out that the future prosperity of the country depends on our ability to develop a knowledge-based economy. Principal, Rev. Fr. Prashant Palackappillil CMI in his address stated that ICT has open up vast opportunities for the learners to enhance their critical thinking and problem solving skills. He mentioned that ICT enables both the teachers and students to access a world beyond the classroom. The resource persons for the program were Mr. Biju V. V. (MOODLE), Dr. Roby Cherian (Screen Castify), Fr. Joseph Kusumalayam (OBS Software) and Dr.mathew George (Google Class room)

Technical Session

Day 1

In Day 1, Mr. Biju gave an excellent overview on various communication and information technologies and how it helps to improve teaching learning process. He pointed out that in future most of the institutions has to change from the conventional chalk and board method to ICT enabled teaching methods as it is becoming one of the criteria for obtaining NAAC and NBA

accreditation. He then discussed in detail about the various components of ICT. He also urged the participants to practice ICT enabled teaching techniques in every possible manner and aspects. The discussion ended with a question and answer session.

Day 2 and Day 3

The technical sessions of Day 2 and Day 3 was fully allotted for the training of MOODLE learning management system. During the sessions, Mr. Biju explained about the various procedures in the MOODLE LMS. He gave a hands on training on how to

- Create an interactive course page in the Moodle,
- Enroll the users for the course
- Upload videos and other study materials in the Moodle
- Create Assignment
- Add questions in the question bank and Conduct a quiz / exam in the Moodle

He also urged the participants to explore the other plugins in the moodle page in every possible manner to make the courses more appealing.

Day 4

The resource person for Day 4 was Dr. Roby Cherian, Department of Physics, Sacred Heart College, Thevara. He discussed about Screencastify, the free chrome extension software that would makes it easy to record, edit, and share videos of the computer screen. In his lecture he explained how to install the Screencastify and explained all the plugins in it. He also demonstrated to the participants on how to record a video using Screencastify and to share the recordings via email, embedding code. He also explained how to share the content in YouTube and Google Classroom.

Day 5

The resource person for Day 5 was Fr. Joseph Kusumalayam, Department of English, Sacred Heart College, Thevara. He discussed about the OBS software which is a free and open source software for video recording and live streaming. In his lecture he showed the participants how to install the software and explained all the components in it. He also demonstrated the participants on how to record the desktop screen using OBS.

Day 6

The resource person for the final day was Dr. Mathew George, Department of Physics, Sacred heart College, Thevara. He discussed about Google Classroom an education platform from

Google, designed to make it easier for education professionals to conduct virtual lessons. He explained to the participants how to

- Sign in
- Create a google classroom for each program
- Share the classroom details to the students
- Assign classwork and grade the assignments

In the final session the participants congratulated the IQAC for organizing the program and shared their views about the program. The program concluded with a vote of thanks by the IQAC joint coordinator.
