
Vice Principal Rev. Dr. Jose John CMI gave the opening remarks. He urged the participants to understand the applications of web of science databases for improving their quality of research.

Spanning all disciplines and regions, *Web of Science Core Collection* is at the heart of the *Web of Science Core Collection* includes only journals that demonstrate high levels of editorial rigor and best practice. Using the *Web of Science Core Collection*, search can be done across the different specialty collections: *Biological Abstracts, BIOSIS Previews, Zoological Record*, and *Current Contents Connect*, as well as the *Chemical Information* products.

The faculty members actively pursuing research and supervising M.Sc. projects participated in the orientation session. Mr. Biju gave them key ideas for obtaining research articles and other resources from these web of science databases.


The IQAC of Sacred Heart College organized a *faculty orientation programme on National Institutions Ranking Framework (NIRF)*. The National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) was approved by the MHRD and launched by Honourable Minister of Human Resource Development on 29th September 2015. This framework outlines a methodology to rank institutions across the country. The methodology draws from the overall recommendations broad understanding arrived at by a Core Committee set up by MHRD, to identify the broad parameters for ranking various universities and institutions. The parameters broadly cover "Teaching, Learning and Resources," "Research and Professional Practices," "Graduation Outcomes," "Outreach and Inclusivity," and "Peer Perception".

The objective of the orientation programme was to make the faculty members aware about different parameters of NIRF Ranking and the procedure of documentation associated with it. The programme was an IQAC initiative. Principal Rev. Dr. Johnson X Palackappillil CMI remarked that it is extremely important for the institution to secure high ranking in NIRF. He urged the faulty members to understand the parameters very well and follow the IQAC protocols for documentation.

IQAC co-ordinator Dr. Joseph T Moolayil presented the details of five parameters of NIRF ranking. He explained all the questions in each parameters. Dr. Joseph insisted that NIRF gives highest priority to teaching, learning & resources with 0.40 ranking weight. The graduation outcomes comes just below teaching, learning & resources with 0.25 ranking weight. He then presented the details of documentation at faculty level, department level and IQAC level.


Dean of Research Dr. Cyriac Antony and HoD Botany Dr. M. S. Francis spoke during the inaugural session of the workshop.





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
