



Melesius Hall, Sacred Heart College, Thevara.

Inaugural Session:

The seminar started at 10 am with prayer and it was inaugurated by Dr. Fr. Johnson X. Palackappillil CMI, the Principal of the College. The inaugural session was followed by technical sessions.

The first technical session "Overview of IPR" was delivered by **Shri. V.P. Balagangadharan**, **Former Scientist, VSSC, Thiruvananthapuram**. He explained the significance, relevance and necessity of IPR. He also elaborated an importance of IPR in the context of the state and central Government's increased emphasis on knowledge production, dissemination, patenting, start-ups etc.

The second session was led by Adv. Febin James, Trademark Attorney & Partner, Legalities IP Services, Trissur discussed patentability Criteria and Patent Filing Procedure.

The third session **Shri. V. A. Vishnu, Project Fellow, PIC-Kerala, KSCSTE**, very clearly explained the "Patent Searching Procedure and support from PIC". All the three technical sessions were followed by discussions and clarifications. The seminar was attended by 24 faculty members. Orientation by Dr. K. M. Johnson:



About the Workshop

Multivariate data analysis and its methodology is an indispensable part of any social science research. The workshop gives special focus on the hands on training of primary data analysis using the statistical package called IBM SPSS Statistics. This workshop covers various statistical tool used for data collection and about the various tests employed to establish the reliability and validity of the collected data for the purpose of analyzing the data to empirically test the hypotheses developed from the literature review in tune with the objectives of the study. 





OBS training:


