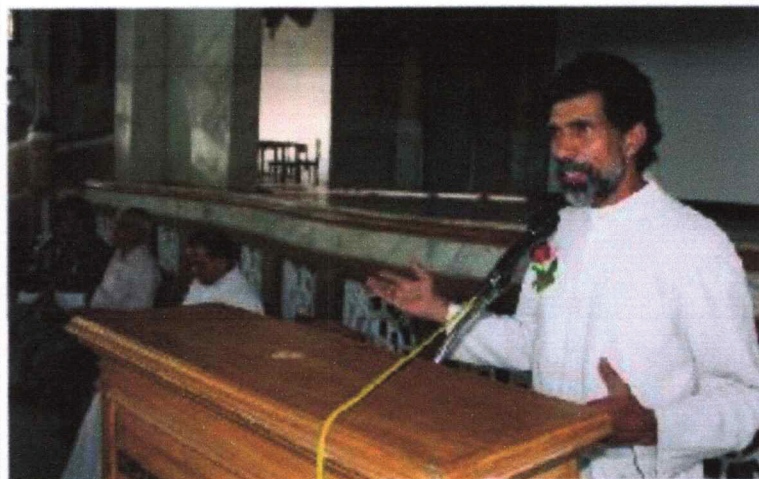


ONE – DAY ORIENTATION ON
