WORLD CANCER DAY (4TH FEBRUARY) OBSERVED ON 29.01.2015

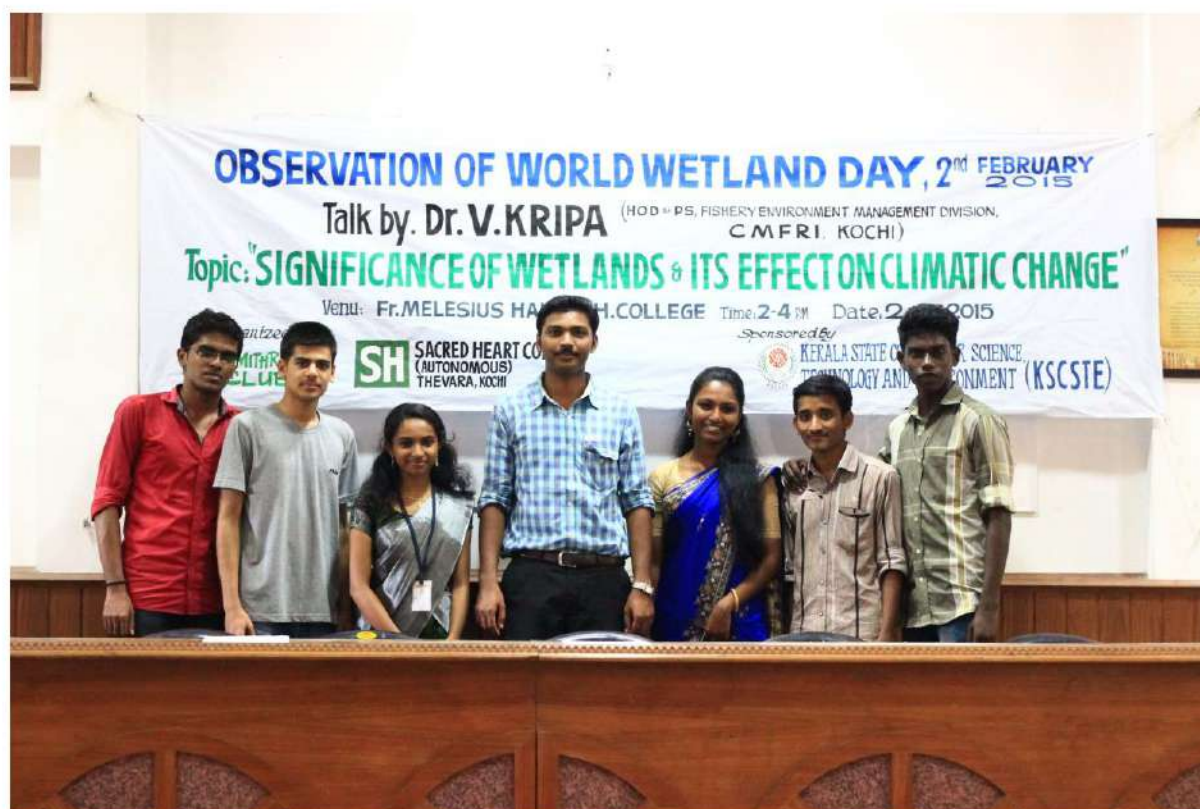
