Environment Day Celebration (05.06.2015)

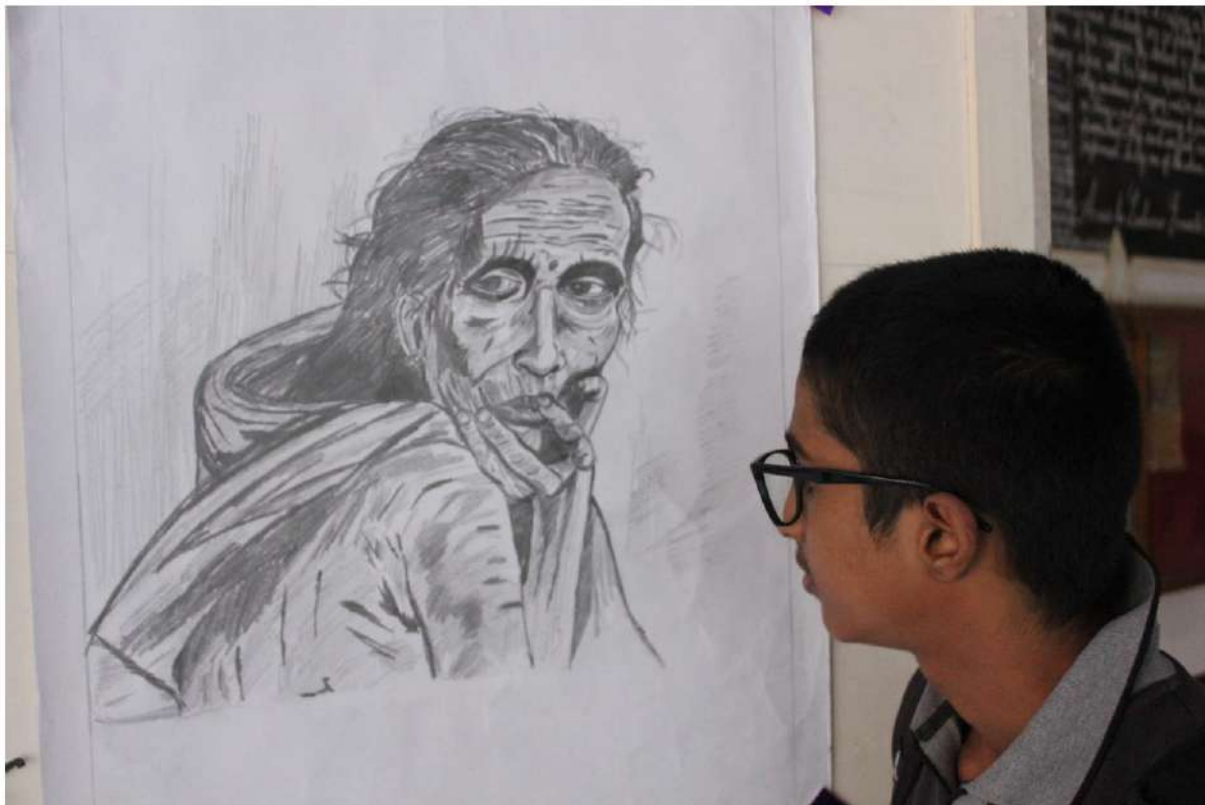
Criterion VII: Institutional Values and Best Practices
