Activity2: "100 Ponds Project" – Pond Cleaning Drive (18/03/2018)

NSS unit of the Sacred Heart College was an active partner in the project for the rejuvenation of the Ponds in Ernakulum, which was initiated by the District Administration with the support of Cochin Shipyard Limited. The maintenance of ponds is essential to retain the ecological balance. On March 18 the volunteers cleaned the pond near the Durbar Hall ground and the activities were led by the District Collector.
