PERPEN – A PAPER PEN REVOLUTION BY RECYCLING WASTE PAPER

The students of Sacred Heart College Thevara has added another milestone to the successful green-protocol initiatives of the college in the form of launching a paper pen project. The idea of producing paper pens in the campus emanated from a green audit report which pointed out the accumulation of heaps of used plastics pens in different parts of the campus. Principal Rev. Dr. Prasant Palacakpillil CMI, who is a renowned green activist, urged the students to avoid the usage of plastic pens and switch to ink pens or paper pens. Students of Chemistry department led by Mr. Sijo Jose and Ms. Somitha Mathew took the challenge of producing paper pens for the campus community. Over 3000 pens have been prepared so far and distributed to students and teachers. College bursar Rev. Dr. Sebastian John CMI supported the students in this entrepreneurship venture and faculty member of Chemistry department Dr. Ignatious Abraham guided this green initiative.
