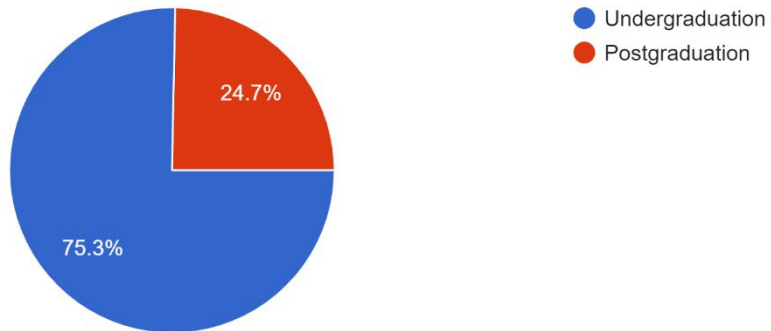

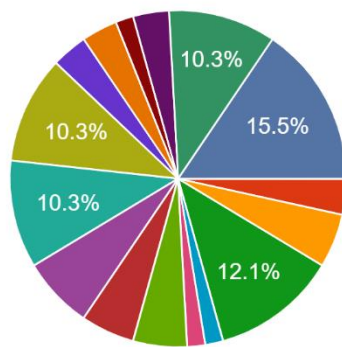


Which programme are you studying now?

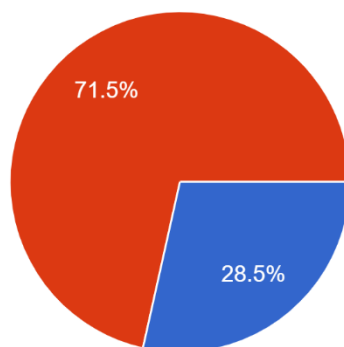

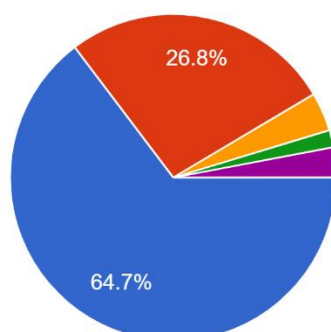

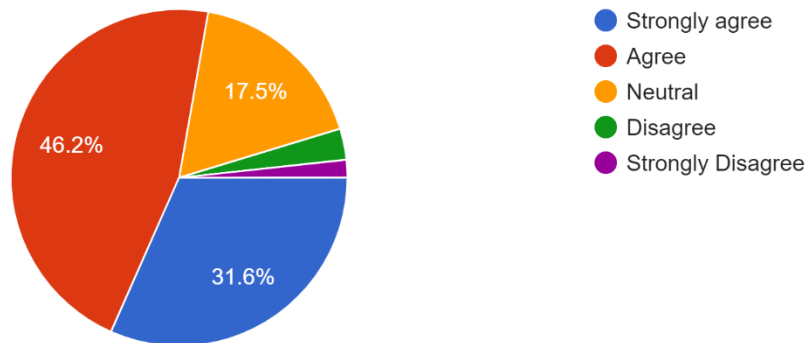

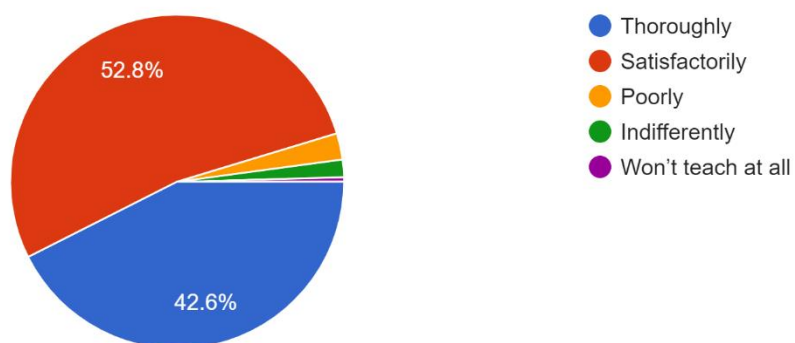

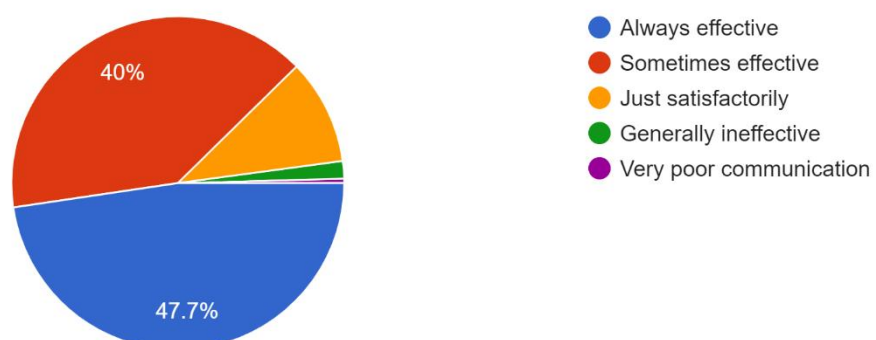
How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?

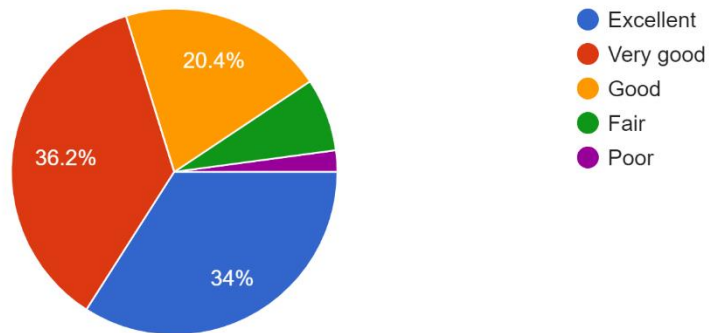
How well were the teachers able to communicate?

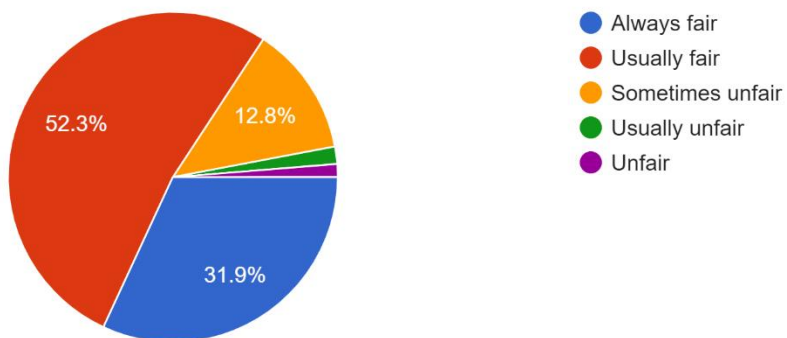
The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as

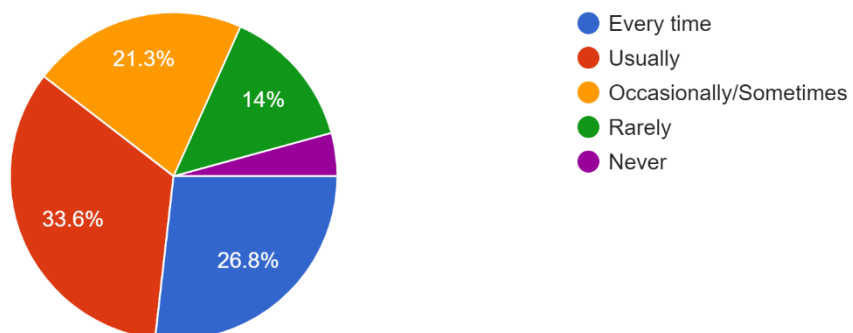

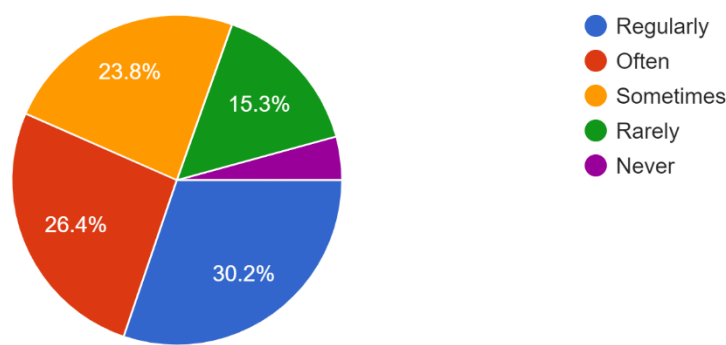

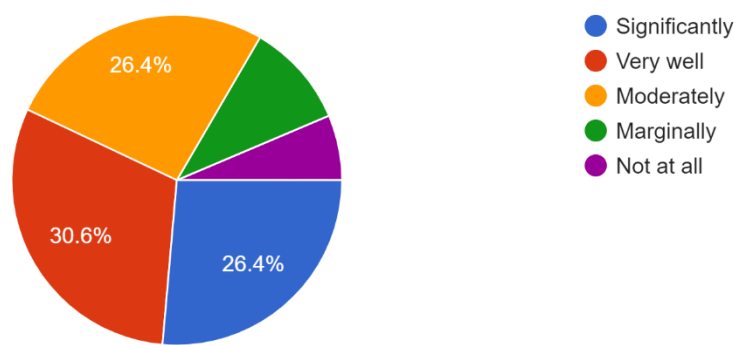

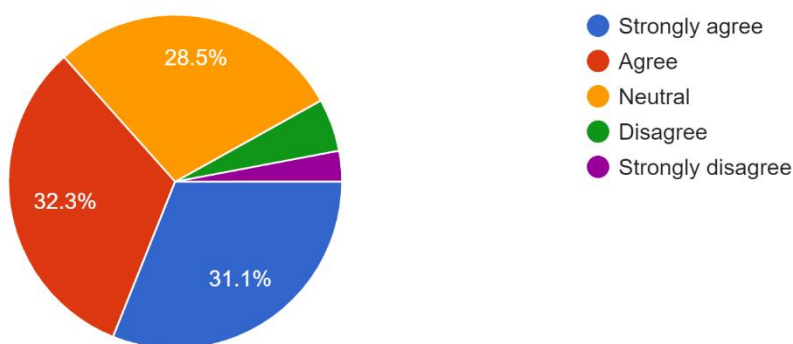

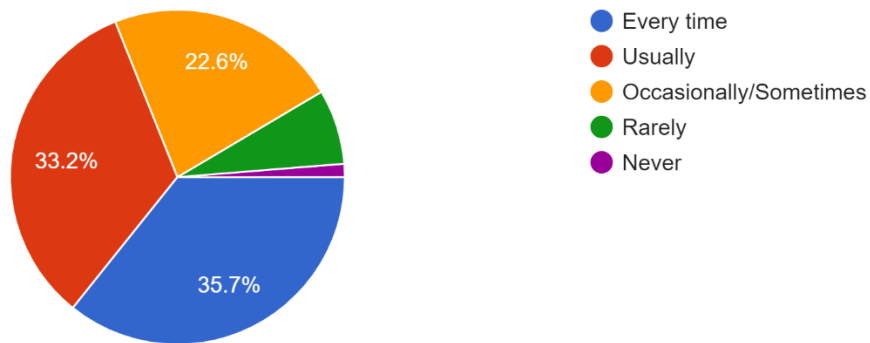

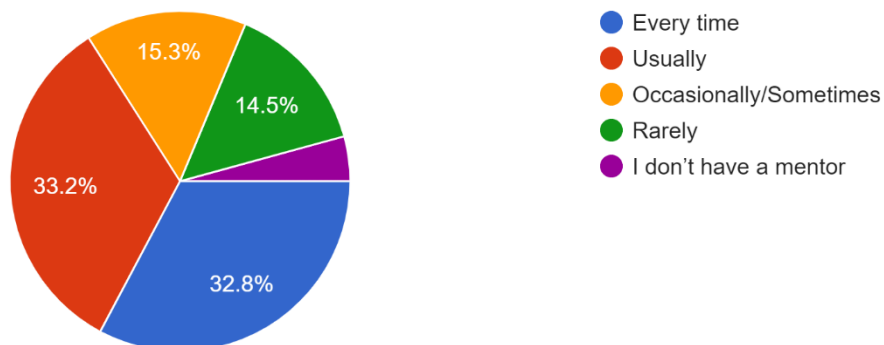

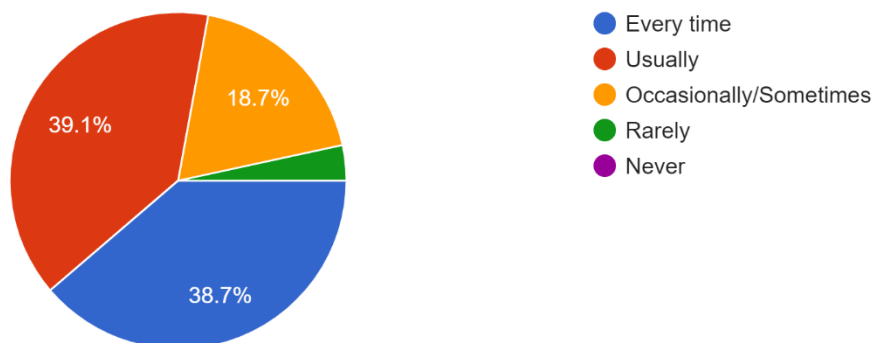

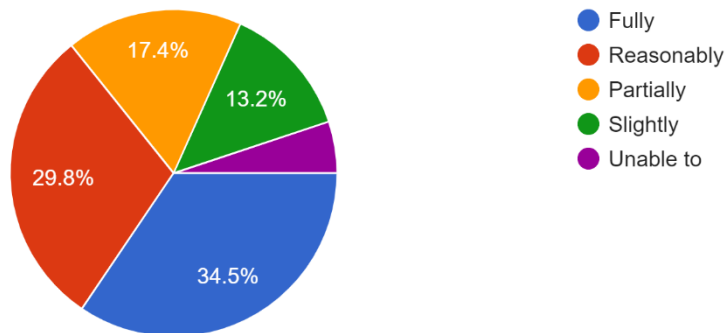

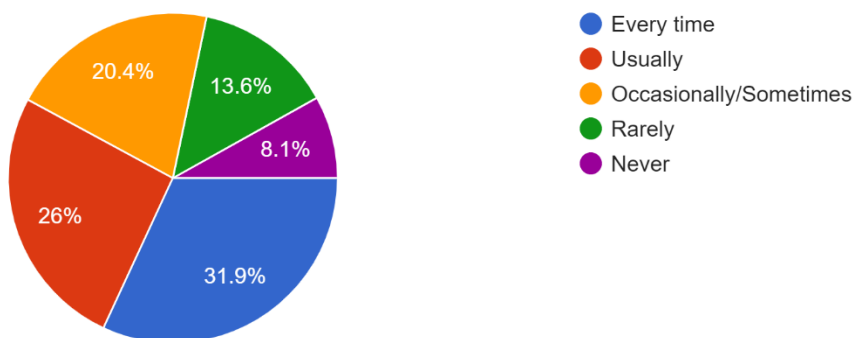

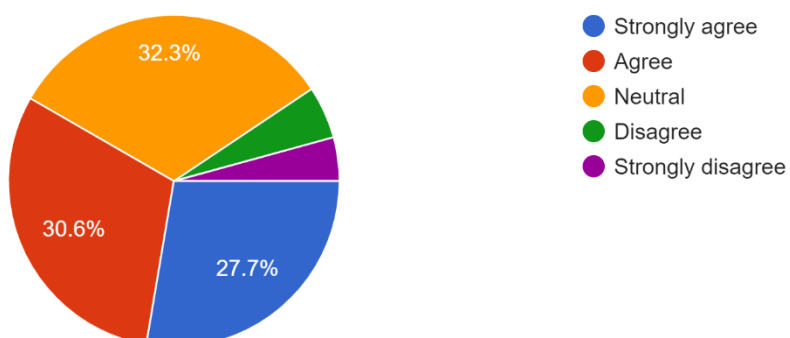

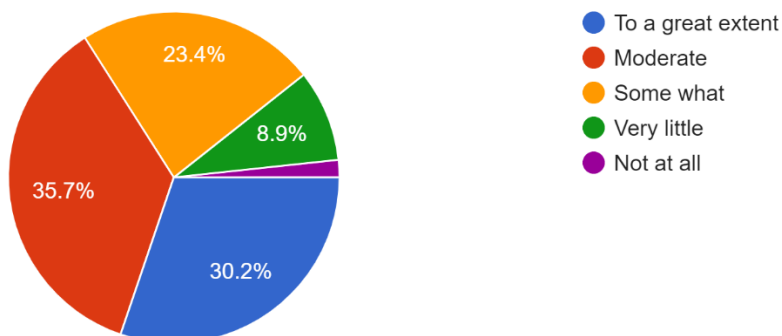

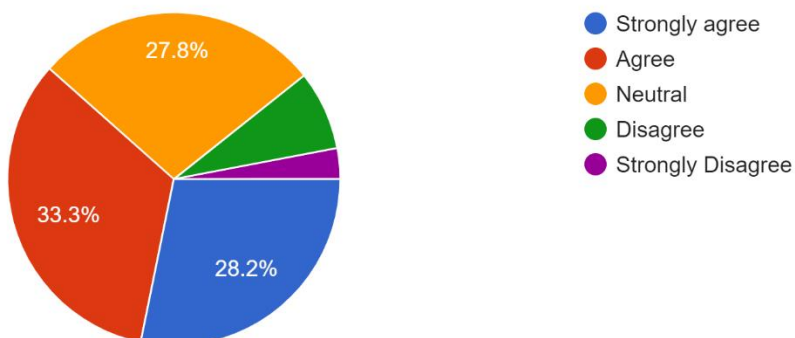

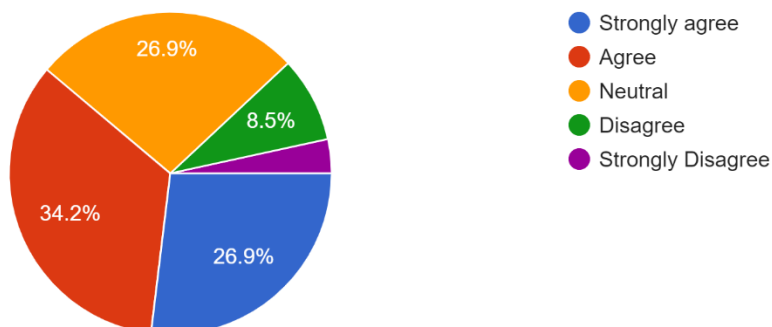

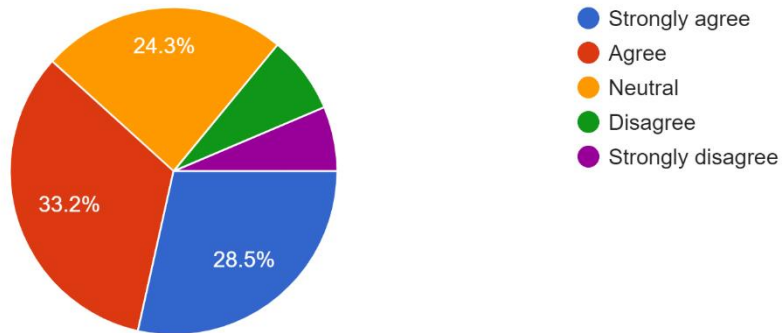

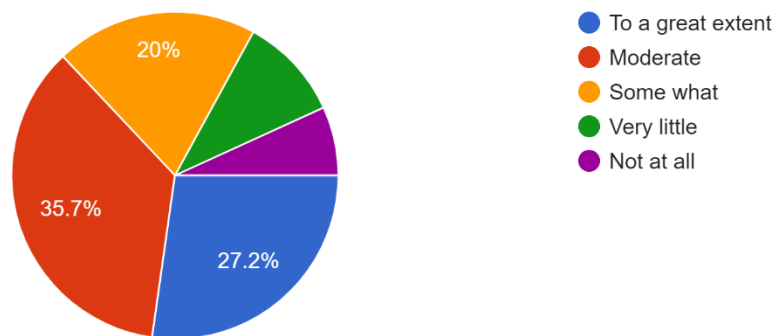

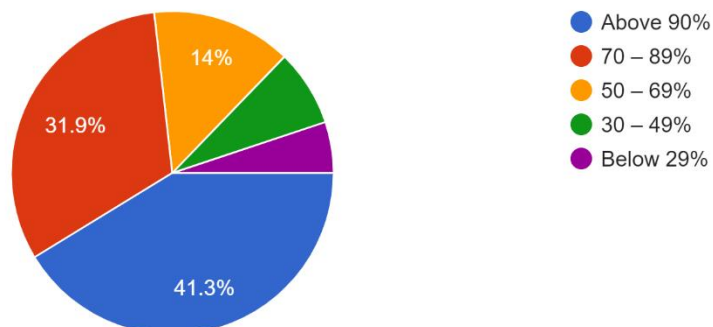
