

FYUGP Major Programme Shifting – Semester III

Guidelines for Major Programme Shifting:

- FYUGP Semester III students may apply for a change of their major programme of study to a new discipline, that has been studied as a minor Discipline Specific Course (DSC) or a Multidisciplinary Course (MDC) during the first two semesters.
- A major programme change is permitted only if the desired major is offered in the college and corresponds to the student's current minor or MDC discipline.
- Students opting to shift their Major to the MDC discipline taken in the first year, must complete two Discipline-Specific Core (DSC) courses at the 100 level to qualify for the degree. It is the responsibility of the student to acquire credits for these 100-level DSC courses of the new Major.
- Major shifting will be permitted subject to the existing vacancies in all major programmes.
- Allotment of Major shifts will be done based on merit, determined by the weighted average of the grade points obtained by the student in the relevant subject during the first and/or second semesters.

Procedure for Major Programme Shifting:

- Students shall log in to SHARMS Portal.
- Navigate to the Course Selection & Programme Change menu and Major Shift / MDC / VAC sub-menu. Click Major Shift.
- The system will display the Minor and MDC disciplines opted during Semester I and II. From the dropdown menu, choose the preferred Major Programme (*only those offered by the college will be available*) and save your preference.
- Generate and print the Major Programme Change Application Form and fill the Grade point (GP) of the relevant courses. Check all the details for accuracy and get the application form duly signed by the student and parent.
- Submit the signed application enclosed with the copies of SEM I & II mark lists to the Faculty Advisor (Class teacher) of your current programme for verification and recommendation.
- The recommended application form enclosed with the copies of SEM I & II mark lists must be personally submitted by the student to the Nodal Officer by 03 June 2025 before 4:00 PM.
- Based on the GP secured for the selected discipline, a rank list will be published on 04 June 2025, 10:00 AM.
- Allotment and final shifting to the new Major Programme will take place on 05 June 2025.
